

POST LOCKDOWN PANDEMIC PROTOCOLS

- 1- All participants and attendees to all LARP Adventures activities will be screened following Virginia Department of Health guidance.
- 2- Participants will be asked if they have been sick or had a fever within the past week (Sun-Sat).
 - a. If so, they will not be allowed to play.
- 3- Participants are asked to Self-Report illness if they get sick during the following week.
- 4- All events will have ample available handwashing stations with sanitizer, soap, water, and paper towels.
 - a. If we run out of hand washing water, sanitizer, or soap, the event ends.
- 5- Provided water will be limited to purchased, bottled water only (you may bring your own container of water or bottled water)
 - a. Community drinking water will not be available
 - b. Bottled Water must be labelled with the user's name to reduce bottle misidentification/cross-contamination
 - c. Bottles are not to be shared
- 6- Participants must keep masked and maintain social distancing, six feet apart when not in play

As part of the safety protocols, all LARP Adventures organizers and participants will be screened in accordance to Virginia Department of Health guidelines.

Below is the official screening questionnaire (please pre-screen before events)

LARP Adventures COVID-19 Screening Protocol: Survey for All Attendees
YES or NO, are you currently experiencing any of the following symptoms? (Yes or No. YOU CAN FAST TRACK YOUR SCREENING BY PROVIDING PROOF OF FULL VACCINATION)

1. A new fever (100.4°F or higher) or a sense of having a fever
2. A new cough that you cannot attribute to another health condition
3. New shortness of breath or difficulty breathing that you cannot attribute to another
4. health condition
5. New chills that you cannot attribute to another health condition
6. A new sore throat that you cannot attribute to another health condition
7. New muscle aches (myalgia) that you cannot attribute to another health condition, or
8. that may have been caused by a specific activity (such as physical exercise)
9. A new loss of taste or smell
10. Have you had a positive test for the virus that causes COVID-19 disease within the past 10 days?

11. In the past 14 days, have you had close contact (within about 6 feet for 15 minutes or more) with someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19?

Anyone who answers YES to ANY of these screening questions should not be permitted to participate or attend. §

§ Healthcare workers using appropriate personal protective equipment during the care of a COVID-19 patient should not be excluded from LARP Adventures participation based on close contact with a COVID-19 patient.

LARP Adventures COVID-19 Protocols Participation Agreement: Infection Control Practices

During your visit, do you agree to: (Yes or No)

1. Immediately notify a staff member if you develop symptoms of COVID-19
2. Practice proper hand hygiene
3. Maintain appropriate physical distance between yourself and others, as much as possible (at least 6 feet when not actively engaged on the field)
4. Limit physical contact between yourself and others, as much as possible
5. Wear a face covering when on or off the field (unless an exception exists per Virginia Executive Order 63)
6. Limit touching surfaces to only what is necessary
7. Abide all related directions from LARP Adventures organizers?

Anyone who answers NO to ANY of these participation agreement questions should not be permitted to participate or attend.
